

18 Steps to take to Outdoor worship at St. Luke's during a pandemic.

With grateful hearts, we take these steps towards in-person community. Out of continued Love of Neighbor, we will:

Before Sunday

1. Go to stlukesdurham.org
2. Click on Signup Link; complete Signup (maximum once per month)
(or go <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10c0c4daeea28a4fcc52-inperson>)
3. The day before worship, complete Screening (any "yes" answers = stay home this week)

Sunday Before Arrival

4. Review symptoms list again and if yes, please stay home this morning.
5. Pack your mask (fits over NOSE AND MOUTH), hand sanitizer, home printed bulletin (or download to phone/tablet), and lawn chair.
6. Wash hands before leaving the house. Do not bring any food or drink and leave your water bottle in the car.

As You Arrive at Church

7. When you drive in, put your mask on (over nose and mouth). Stop to speak with our Hospitality Coordinator (located near the turn into the breezeway). You will be asked to confirm you are symptom-free and invited to park.
8. With masks on, proceed to the outdoor usher table; maintain 6 feet of distance from any other household or individual. Please no physical greetings (hand shake, hug, etc.).
9. Give your name to the usher, use hand sanitizer, place your lawn chair 6 feet from other households. Do not remove your mask until you return to your car.
10. If you have an offering, please leave it in the offering box at the Usher Table.
11. Seating is marked by colored cones. Usher can help direct you to seating as needed.
12. If you find you must sneeze or cough, do not remove your mask! You may get a new mask from an usher or in the restroom. Thoroughly wash/hand sanitize after putting on fresh mask.
13. Restrooms are now one person/pod at a time. Wash hands well after use and wipe all surfaces and door handles with provided wipes (do NOT flush wipes--dispose in trash). Hand sanitize prior to entering worship area.
14. There will be no contact during the passing of the peace, and you will stay in place and be given instructions about how to receive the bread.
15. There will be no coffee hour or socializing after service at this time.

Leaving Church

16. Exit the outdoor worship area, still masked, keeping 6 feet distance from others.
17. Please don't congregate; do not remove your mask until you are in your car.
