

INDOOR worship at St. Luke's

With grateful hearts, we move forward with our in-person worship.

Please follow the guidelines for worship below:

Sunday Before Arrival

1. If you are sick, have any symptoms, or may have been exposed to COVID-19 please stay home this morning.
2. Pack your mask (you will need it if singing), hand sanitizer, and bulletin (print or download to phone/tablet). Bulletins at <https://stlukesdurham.org/resources-for-in-person-worship/> scroll down. Printed bulletins will also be available at the church.

As You Arrive at Church

3. At the entryway, stop and speak with our Ushers or Greeters. If you are new to St. Luke's-Welcome!
4. We are still refraining from physical greetings (handshake, hug, etc.) at this time.
5. Wearing a mask during worship is strongly recommended for unvaccinated individuals but is optional for those fully vaccinated, and **is required for all** while singing. Unvaccinated persons are more susceptible to infection and serious illness.
6. Please bring personal hand sanitizer to use after touching your mask.
7. If you would like to make an offering, please leave it in the offering plate in the center aisle in the church.
8. If you find you must sneeze or cough, please continue to practice good respiratory hygiene by doing so into your sleeve.
9. Please refrain from physical contact outside of your family/pod during the passing of the peace.
10. Ushers will guide you to communion.
11. Coffee hour will be available beginning Easter Sunday after the services in the Sprague room. Feel free to take your beverages outside if you are more comfortable.

Leaving Church

12. Outside remains the best place to socialize.

Alert the church if you become symptomatic or test positive for COVID 19 within 14 days of service by leaving a message at 919-286-2273 or e-mail interim-rector@stlukesdurham.org.

No gathering can be completely safe. Unvaccinated people remain susceptible to contracting COVID-19. Singing and removal of masks can increase transmission from infected individuals. We will continue to monitor circumstances and adjust policy as required
