Donation Guidelines

The Fling will be here before you know it, and it's time to clean out your closets, attics, garage, wherever to donate to St. Luke's largest outreach event! The following guidelines will help you decide on appropriate items to bring and help us all have a profitable sale.

- All items should be clean, mended, working and in good repair. We can't sell torn, dirty or broken items, so please do not bring them.
- NO Clothing items, please!
- Linens must be clean, folded, marked with size, and if possible, put in ziplock bags or other storage container to keep clean and organized.
- All donations will be accepted in Johnson Hall beginning **the Sunday before the sale through WEDNESDAY before the sale.**
- Bring only furniture that you can easily bring to the church. We can't pick up large pieces.
- We have many types of merchandise accepted, but the following items will **NOT** be accepted:
 - Toys that are broken or missing pieces
 - Clothing or shoes
 - Mattresses and bed pillows
 - Futons and waterbeds
 - Sleeper sofas
 - Old, worn upholstered furniture in poor condition
 - Large appliances (please clean any appliances prior to drop-off)
 - Exercise bikes/treadmills that cannot be proven to work
 - CRTs - these are Cathode Ray Tube televisions
 - Any electronic device and accessories that do not work
(e.g. computers and associated equipment, DVDs, TVs etc)
 - Computer software
 - Child car seats, cribs
- Book Department accepts: gently used books, audiobooks, DVDs, CDs.
- The Book Department will **NOT be accepting:**
 - VCR tapes
 - books without intact covers and binding
 - books with water or mold damage
 - Reader's Digest condensed books
 - encyclopedias
 - textbooks
 - magazines
 - VHS tapes
 - cassettes
